

What does it cost?

This is an important factor for schools who are considering Odyssey of the Mind to meet their STEAM, Common Core and 21st Century Skills needs.

The Michigan Odyssey of the Mind program is a bargain!

World Membership \$135.00

There are also discounts available for multiple memberships within a school district.

This cost covers one team in each of the five problems as well as Primary teams.

You will receive a membership packet that includes the six problems (1-Primary and 5-Competitive Level problems), the Program Guide, activities to include in classroom curriculums and other information at the national level.

State Membership \$ 50.00

This fee covers your membership in Michigan Odyssey tournaments.

Total membership cost:

\$185.00

In addition to the Membership Cost, there is a competition fee for each team.

Competition Fee \$ 50.0

This is for each competing team and includes regional and state competitions in one fee. This also includes Primary teams at the regional level.

The competition fee covers the cost of running the tournaments.

Example: If you represent a K-6 elementary school and have 1 team in the Primary Division, 3 teams competing in different problems in Division I (3-5th grades), and 2 6th grade teams (Division II) competing in different problems, you would pay the following:

One world membership One state membership Six competition fees @ \$50 each (1Primary, 3-Div 1, 2-Div II)	\$ 135.00 50.00 300.00
Total of all fees	\$ 485.00

That \$485.00 cover all fees for 42 kids (6 teams x 7 team members) for all competitions. That's just over \$11.50 per child for months of creative thinking and teamwork! And, the more teams you have competing in different problems under your membership, the lower the cost per team member.
